Ventana Sur: PTI On Board For World Cup Trophy Robbery Picture Tree Takes On Brazilian Con Comedy JULES AND DOLORES and Presents High-Profile Titles at Ventana Sur

Berlin, November 29, 2015 – Prior to the upcoming **Ventana Sur** in Buenos Aires (30 November – 4 December 2015), Berlin-based **Picture Tree International** (PTI) has added Brazilian production **JULES AND DOLORES** to the slate. The pop comedy is based on a striking fact in Brazilian soccer history: for 13 years, three-time world cup winner Brazil had proudly displayed legendary Jules Rimet Trophy at the Brazilian Football Association's headquarters in Rio de Janeiro, when, in 1983, the highly coveted and extremely valuable trophy was stolen from its cabinet. Directed by Caíto Ortiz, **JULES AND DOLORES** tells the preposterous and unusual story behind this bold theft. The film was produced by Francesco Civita and Beto Gauss for Prodigo Films. Paris Filmes and Netflix will be releasing the film in Brazil Latin and Central America with PTI handling international sales.

JULES AND DOLORES is the newest acquisition for Berlin-based sales company PTI, which successfully marketed Brazilian titles THE PILGRIM – PAULO COELHO'S BEST STORY and 2015 Berlin Panorama opener BLUE BLOOD before. At this year's Ventana Sur, PTI will present two high-profile European films to Latin American buyers: Elisabeth Scharang's haunting psychograph JACK (Austria 2015) about Austrian acclaimed poet and serial killer Jack Unterweger, which premiered at Locarno and TIFF, as well as Bora Dagtekin's record-breaking FACK JU GOEHTE 2 (Germany 2015), the current leader of the 2015 German box office charts with more than 7.5 million admissions (domestic distributor: Constantin Film). The comedy has been holding Top 5 positions in the Czech Republic, Slovakia (Cinemart) and Hungary (Big Bang) for several weeks now and it has already been sold to a number of further international territories such as Russia (Luxor), France (SND), Italy (Medusa) during AFM, .

Lionsgate affiliate Pantelion Films is currently shooting a Hispanic remake of the first installment **FACK JU GOEHTE** in co-production with Constantin. Starring Mexican star comedian Omar Chaparro as the con teacher, **NO MANCHES FRIDA**, thus the new title, is set for a 2016 Labor Day weekend release in the US.
